Go-Bag Emergency Checklist

Documents and Money

- Copies of ID and important documents (passport, driver's license, insurance)
- Cash (small bills) and backup credit/debit card
- Emergency contact list (printed)
- Medical records, allergy info, prescription list

Food and Water

- At least 1 liter of water per person per day (3-day supply)
- Non-perishable snacks (energy bars, canned food)
- Reusable utensils and manual can opener

Clothing and Warmth

- Change of clothes (underwear, socks, shirt, sweater)
- Raincoat or windbreaker
- Hat and gloves (for cold weather)
- Sturdy walking shoes

Hygiene Supplies

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Wet wipes and toilet paper
- Hand sanitizer and soap
- Towel and comb
- Feminine hygiene products

- First Aid Kit

- Pain relievers and fever reducers
- Personal medications
- Band-aids, antiseptic, gauze
- Anti-allergy meds and burn cream
- Face masks and disposable gloves

Communication and Navigation

- Phone charger and power bank
- Flashlight with batteries or hand crank
- Battery-powered or solar radio
- Local map and compass

Safety Tools

- Multi-tool or pocket knife
- Lighter or waterproof matches
- Needle and thread, duct tape

- Whistle for signaling
- Pepper spray (optional)

For Children (if applicable)

- Baby food and bottle
- Diapers and wipes
- Blanket and comfort toy
- Extra baby clothes

□ For Pets (optional)

- Pet food and bowl
- Leash or carrier
- Pet medications

Other Essentials

- Emergency blanket (space blanket)
- Notebook and pen
- *Cold pack or heat pack
- Plastic or waterproof bags

Tip: review and refresh your go-bag every 3-6 months (food dates, meds, power bank charge).
